A request has been made by the Sandy Bay Yacht Club, host club for this summer's 2021 Bullseye Nationals, to reduce the required number of races attempted in normal, safe conditions to FIVE total regatta races from the SEVEN regatta races required under our Rules for Regattas to maximize local fleet participation. Their request is due to COVID challenges and due to the older average age of the skippers in their fleet. A more detailed explanation of their reasoning can be found in the Background section just prior to the voting line on the Proxy.

Please note that the vote will be for a **ONE-TIME** reduction in the number of required races specifically limited to the 2021 Bullseye Nationals at Sandy Bay Yacht Club

Under the Bullseye Sailing Association's Constitution, specifically Article VIII – Revisions to Association Rules which includes Rules for Regattas, a one-month notification must be given to vote on **ANY** changes. As we are within one month of the previously scheduled Annual Meeting and the request came in after the notification period had expired, it is prudent to simply schedule a Special Meeting rather than reschedule the Annual Meeting.

We hope that you exercise your right to vote and do so by proxy or we hope will connect/call-in and participate in our Special Meeting and vote in person!
